AFRICA:

There is a severe fuel crisis in Liberia, which impacts the cost of public transport. Pray for relief, especially as the members of the FMC in Liberia are traveling to their Provisional Annual Conference next week.

Desert locusts are ravaging eastern portions of Africa. Reports say it is the worst invasion of locusts in Kenya in 70 years. Eleven of Kenya's 47 counties have faced significant destruction. Bishop Hawkins Mugaya has not yet received reports of church members being affected, but there is fear that those in Samburu and Lamu are in danger. There is potential for a significant impact on food supplies and livelihoods. Some news reports say the locusts are expected to invade not only Kenya but Uganda, Tanzania, Somalia and Ethiopia. Pray for the Lord to protect and provide for His people during this time.

Please continue in faithful prayer for our brothers and sisters in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). Pray for an end to the targeted ethnic cleansing of thousands of people. Pray for God to bring peace and healing, where both seem impossible. Pray for the Lord to provide for the thousands who have lost their homes, crops and cattle. In addition to the violence, there continues to be a severe outbreak of Ebola in the DRC. Pray for God to bring physical, spiritual, emotional and relational healing in this country.
